Call for Papers

NLR welcomes the submission of unsolicited manuscripts on various subject related to law and justice. This journal has wider access to range of communities working in legal sector and is further used by other academic and none-academic communities. The submissions must not have been published, submitted or accepted elsewhere. The articles are subject to peer-review process; the final decision on publication is decided by the Editor-in-Chief and only shortlisted articles will be further communicated for the publication purpose. The review reserves the right to edit, modify, alter or reject based on quality and novelty of the submission. The acceptance notification will be duly communicated with the author for the further improvements. The refusal of articles will not be communicated by editorial team. The probable author may be further communicated by editorial team for furnishing, quality checking, plagiarism report, etc. in due course of process of editing and publishing.

Submission Guidelines:

- The manuscripts shall be between 5000-7000 words excluding footnotes. This word-count is mandatory for author before submitting to journal. The author is requested not to make unnecessary explanation, briefing, comment or any information as not significant for major points of submission in footnotes.
- The manuscripts must be accompanied by an abstract. It can be up to 250 words with 3 major key words.
- The manuscripts may be authored by up to 2 co-authors.
- All works must be original and unpublished, and must not be pending for review before any other journal. Plagiarism beyond 15% shall not be accepted. The submission extending the plagiarism above 15 % will not be communicated for improvishment hence before submitting to journal, each author is humbly requested to examine their submission on plagiarism report.
- The manuscripts must be submitted in Microsoft word format with proper structure and typo.
- The main body of the paper should be in Times New Roman style, font size 12, with 1.5 line spacing, and footnotes in Times New Roman Style, Size 10, with 1.0 line spacing. All headings must have uniform formatting.
- Each author is mandatory required to follow *bluebook citation style, 21st edition* for their paper.
- Nepal Law Campus shall be the sole copyright owner of all the published materials.
- The Editorial board reserves the right to make final decisions regarding the conditions, guidelines and publication mentioned herein.
- The manuscripts shall be submitted to nepallawreveiw@nlc.edu.np.
- The submission deadline is 25th September 2023.
