Nepal Law Review, a peer reviewed journal is an annual publication of Nepal Law Campus, Tribuvan University.


Nepal Law Campus invites submissions from law practitioners, academicians, members of bench and bureaucracy, research scholars, and law graduates that are original and unpublished manuscripts on contemporary issues relating to law and justice.

Submission Guidelines:

- The manuscripts shall be between 3000-5000 words.
- The manuscripts must be accompanied by an abstract. It can be upto 300 words.
- The manuscripts may be authored by up to 2 co-authors.
- All works must be original and unpublished, and must not be pending for review before any other journal. Plagiarism beyond 15% shall not be accepted.
- The manuscripts must be submitted in Microsoft word format. Submission shall be typewritten.
- The main body of the paper should be in Times New Roman style, font size 12, with 1.5 line spacing, and footnotes in Times New Roman Style, Size 10, with 1.0 line spacing. All headings must have uniform formatting.
- All footnotes should conform to the Bluebook Style of Citation (21st Edition). In-text citation shall not be accepted.
- The manuscripts shall be blind peer-reviewed. Only those manuscripts approved by the peer-review process shall be published in the journal.
- Nepal Law Campus shall be the sole copyright owner of all the published materials.
- The Editorial board reserves the right to make final decisions regarding the conditions, guidelines and publication mentioned herein.

- The submission deadline is 20 December 2022.
