

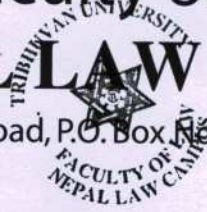


Call for Research Proposal

 - IV. Synopsis of research plan
 - V. Academic certification
 - VI. CV
5. **Submission Process:** Proposal should be submitted at info@nlc.edu.np
6. **Proposal Submission Deadline :** 2nd Kartik 2081 B.S. before 4:00 PM
7. **Tenure of Research Work:** To be completed by 31st of Jestha 2082 B.S.
